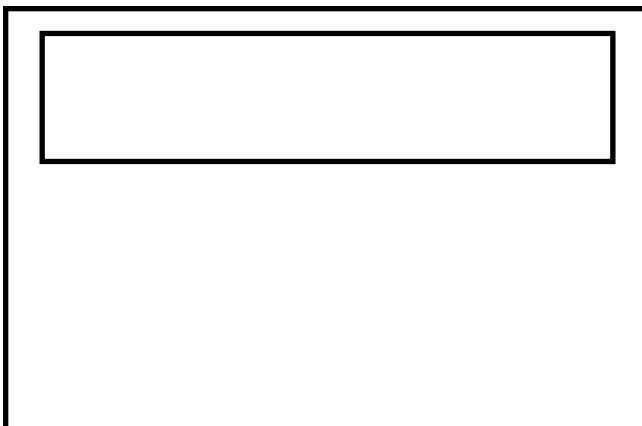

AMATEUR ADULT - One who makes his/her living connected with photography, such as in a camera store, as a photography teacher, or as in a darkroom technician, will be classified as an Advanced Amateur. Also, one who derives less than half of his income from photography and/or does all of his/her own work. Also, any amateur is defined as one who has not won a Special Award in photography in a previous Park County Fair.
